	Hazard Detail	Controlled Risk	Protective/Preventative Measures
1.	Non-pest prevention personnel being affected by the application.	Low	Vacate treatment areas before application. Do not spray directly into breeze/wind. Use in well ventilated areas. Keep out of reach of children. Remove empty spray can from site and dispose of correctly.
2.	Pest prevention personnel being affected by the treatment.	Low	Apply the insecticide according to the label recommendations. Wear non-absorbent gloves and an appropriate respiratory protection equipment. Wear goggles and an appropriate coverall. Wash hands thoroughly at the end of the treatment.
3.	Non target animals being affected by the treatment.	Low	Do not spray directly into breeze/wind. Use in well ventilated areas. Clear all animals from the area to be treated. Remove or cover all fish tanks or bowls before application. Remove all empty spray cans from the site. Do not contaminate waterbodies or watercourses with these packaging.
4.	Spillage	Low	The nature of this product, when contained in commercial packs, makes spillage unlikely. However, if significant amounts are spilled nevertheless, rapidly recover the product. To do so, wear a mask and protective clothing. Wash with plenty of water.
5.	Disposal	High	Dispose of empty spray cans to a licensed hazardous-waste disposal contractor or collection site.
6.	Fire	Low	Do not inhale explosion and combustion gases. Burning produces heavy smoke. Immediately inform emergency services of the type of product and supply them with health and safety data sheet.
7.	Theft of Product	Medium	Ensure product is kept locked away in the manufacturers approved container when not being applied. In case of theft, inform the emergency services of the type and quantity of the product involved. Supply emergency services with health and safety data sheet.
8.	Poisoning	Low	Immediately contact the doctor or vet and show them the product label or health and safety data sheet. Do not induce vomiting.
9.	Inhalation	Low	Wear the recommended face protection and respiratory protection equipment during the treatment.
10.	Skin Absorption	Low	Wear non-absorbent gloves when applying and disposing of the insecticide. Wear an appropriate coverall during the treatment.
11.	Eye contact	Low	Rinse immediately with clean water and seek medical advice.
12.	Environmental Risk	Low	Ensure that the product is disposed of according to the label recommendations.
13.	Exposure Monitoring and Health Surveillance	Medium	Not necessary under normal application circumstances.
